World Open Leek Launching Championships

Wheatsheaf Public House 6th September 2009.

The objective: To propel a standard leek vertically the highest.

Rules

1. The leek must be propelled by the use of mechanical means only.
2. No combustible propellants or compressed air to be used (gas, solid fuel, liquids, gunpowder, any form of hydraulics etc.)
3. The device must pass a safety inspection (To be devised)
4. The device must be operated by one person, that person being the entrant.
5. The entrant is allowed three attempts.
6. The leek must detach completely from the device for a successful launch to be recorded.
7. There must be nothing attached to the leek once airborne.
8. The whole leek must be used, from root to where flags (leaves) divide.
9. All firing leeks will be supplied by the Leek Club. They will have a diameter of 2.5 cm. and length of 25cm – approximately
10. The height the leek achieves will be judged by 3 independent adjudicators standing an equal distance from the launch position (same distance for each entry)
